

EDISON BOYS' SOCCER VOLUNTEER INFORMATION

<u>BOOSTER CLUB BOARD</u> -The Booster Club board provides support for the coaches and teams to build and maintain a premier program. Positions become available on a yearly basis, and we strive to add new members each year. The Booster Club in no way influences who is selected for a particular team, what position any player plays, or how much time any player plays. We provide financial and organizational support.

<u>TEAM REPRESENTATIVES</u> -Each team (Varsity, Junior Varsity, and Frosh/Soph) will need one representative to serve as liaisons to the booster board and the team coach. Team admins are responsible for coordinating various activities and communicating important information onto parents and/or players. We strongly encourage the team admin to delegate some of the following jobs to other parents on the team. This allows everyone to get involved. Tasks for this position may include but not limited to team roster cheat sheets and distribution and sending weekly emails announcing and promoting all events and program activities to ensure success.

<u>FUNDRAISERS</u> -Coordinating fund raising efforts. Fundraising not only helps keep our recommended player donations from increasing, but it also helps pay for field improvements, equipment, and long-term projects. We're always looking for new ideas for raising money for our program. These funds may accumulate for several years to satisfy future program needs.

<u>PHOTOGRAPHERS</u> -Photographers are needed for action shots, candid shots, other soccer related photos for publication in the yearbook and memory book. Our goal is to have game photographs of every team, every player and our coaches.

<u>YEAR-END MEMORY BOOK</u> -The Booster Club produces a soccer memory book at the end of every season as a memento for the players. The memory book is an opportunity to highlight the season and includes pictures, stats, player bios and player dedications pages.

<u>TEAM DINNERS</u> -Pasta dinners the night before league home games is an Edison tradition! You will receive more gratification from this than you can imagine. All dinners will be at Edison High school.

<u>BANQUET-</u>The final event of our season is our soccer banquet, which provides a great opportunity to recognize players, coaches, and volunteers. Volunteers are needed to help coordinate the banquet according to school guidelines at a designated location, and to decorate, clean up, provide overall assistance.
